Benefits of WebCT Content Migration Utility

- Course designers can author course content outside of WebCT
- Administrators may easily migrate courses to newer versions of WebCT
- Institutions will protect their capital and intellectual investments using a standardized format
- Learning resources developed in WebCT can be shared with any compliant system





IMS Content Migration Utility

- Released July 30, 2001
- Archiving data in a non-proprietary format
- Encourages re-usability and portability

Imports and exports complete courses --and "epacks", using IMS

Content Format

Content Packaging 1.1

Packaging content using an IMS manifest that organizes and describes the course contents

Question & Test Interoperability 1.1


 Describing and tagging assessment information for self-tests and quizzes

Learning Resource Meta-Data 1.1

- Data that describes the course package and the learning content –type of resources, files
- WebCT Defined XML
 - Used to define proprietary learning tools, format and style information

Why We Used Non-Standard

- Extensions that provide formatting and additional feature support
- Vocabulary that describes WebCT pedagogical tools
- WebCT XML is used to package resources where specifications are not yet available
 - Glossary
 - Syllabus






